



Weekly Data by Region, State, and Conflict Type



Eighteen Nigerian states recorded 29 violent incidents resulting in 61 casualties (deaths and injuries) and eight kidnap victims between the 9th and 15th of April, 2023. There was a significant reduction in casualty and kidnap counts compared to the preceding week. With 21 recorded deaths, Kaduna is the focal state for the week. Separate attacks by bandits on civilians and informal security personnel in the state's Zangon Kataf and Birnin Gwari Local Government Areas contributed to the high figure. Kaduna also has the highest violent incident tally, with five cases involving bandits, security personnel, and civilians. While Kogi state has the highest kidnap count, with three victims from one incident. Gunmen violence has remained the week's focal violent conflict, with eight incidents resulting in five casualties and eight kidnap victims. Banditry comes second, with 33 deaths from seven incidents.
