




Weekly Data by Region, State, and Conflict Type






Nextier Violent Conflict Data by Region

In this review week (20th - 26th October 2024), twelve violent incidents resulted in 38 fatalities and five kidnap victims across seven Nigerian states. Although the conflict impacted fewer states, the fatality figures are still high. Anambra state ranked the highest in incidents and fatalities counts. The state recorded three violent incidents involving cult gangs, civilians, and yet-to-be-identified gunmen. These incidents resulted in 20 deaths. The clash of cult gangs in Nibo community of Awka South Local Government Area, where 16 persons were killed, contributed to the state's high tally. Three persons were abducted in Benue State within the same period. Cult Clashes is the prevalent violent conflict for the week, with 25 fatalities from four incidents. Banditry is second, with three incidents resulting in seven deaths and five kidnap victims. The North Central and South East regions of the country are the most troubled in the review period, with each recording four incidents that led to six fatalities, five kidnap victims in the North Central and 22 deaths in the South East.
