

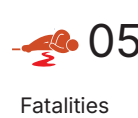

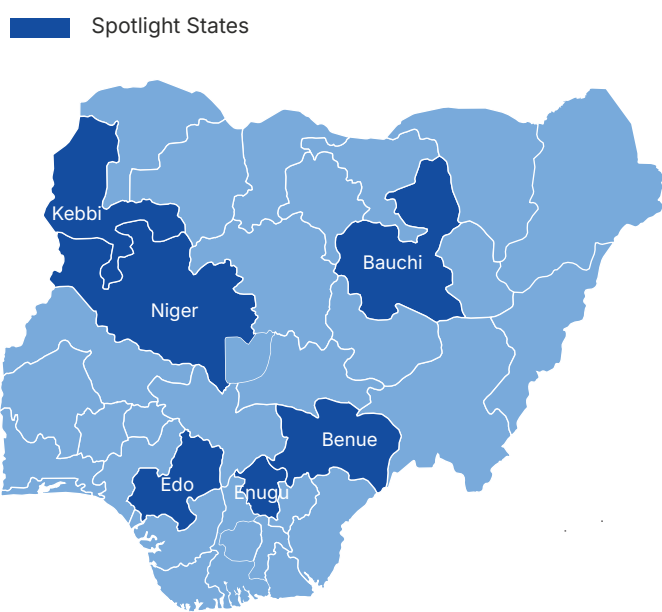

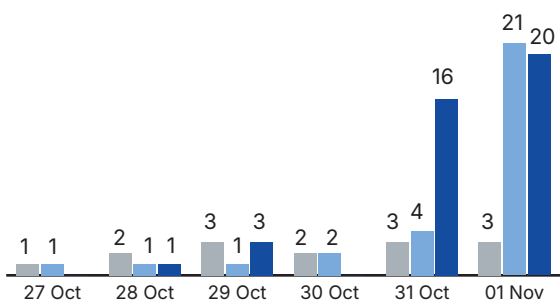

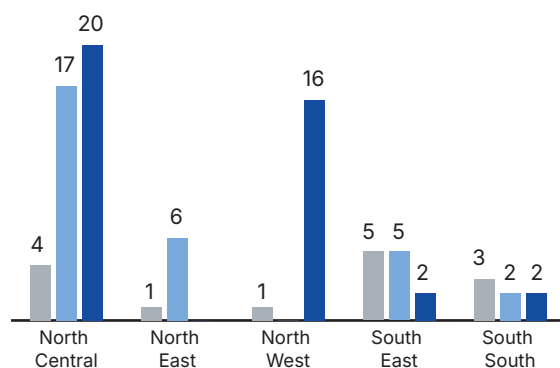

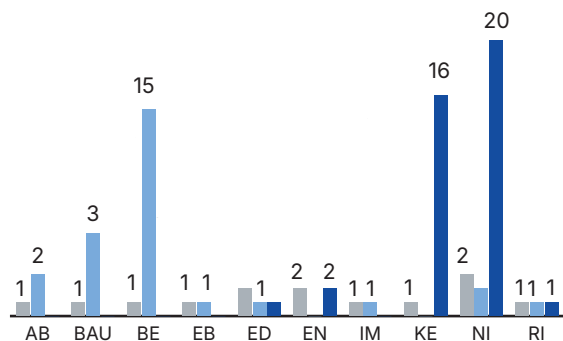

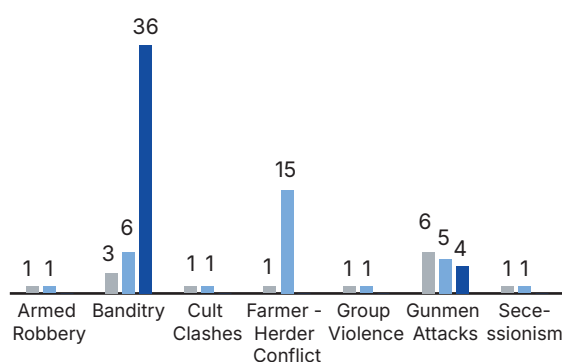
Nextier Violent Conflict Data by Region

Between October 27 and November 2, 2024, 30 casualties (29 fatalities and one injured victim) and 40 kidnap victims were recorded from 14 incidents across 10 Nigerian states. There were increases in incidents and kidnap count compared to the [previous week](#). Benue state recorded the most fatalities, with 15 cases due to an [attack by suspected armed herders](#) on Anyiin community, Logo Local Government Area (LGA). Niger State recorded the highest violent incident tally, involving civilians, armed robbers, hoodlums, informal security actors and bandits. The state also recorded the most kidnap cases, with 20 victims from one incident. Gunmen violence is the prevalent conflict type, with five fatalities and four kidnap victims from six incidents in the review week. Banditry is second, with six deaths and 36 kidnap victims from three incidents. South East is the most volatile region in the review period, recording five incidents that resulted in five fatalities and two kidnap victims.
